Dr. Ana Veríssimo is a marine biologist with a background in fisheries science. Her research has focused on clarifying the population structure and connectivity of commercially exploited fisheries resources, particularly using molecular genetic tools. She has also applied these tools to address other questions relevant to the biology and ecology of marine fish taxa, namely to monitor freshwater and marine fish diversity using eDNA metabarcoding, performing molecular species identification of egg and larvae stages, or studying the trophic ecology of early life stages of marine fish using metabarcoding.
