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Carla Gameiro is a Researcher at the Portuguese Institute for Sea and Atmosphere (IPMA). She has a PhD in marine ecology, specialised in marine phytoplankton dynamics and primary production from the University of Lisbon. For the last 6 years she has been the manager of the National Fisheries Data Collection Program (PNAB/DCF), collaborating in the coordination of the team of technicians and researchers and identifying the necessary resources for all the activities of the program, including the research surveys at sea. She is also currently involved in research to support the mission implementation in the Atlantic and Arctic Basin with focus on restoration of marine and coastal ecosystems and increased climate resilience that will support the implementation of the EU Mission “Restore our Ocean” and waters by 2030; research in the development of biochemical traceability tools for marine food products and identifying of ecological indicators by analysing the relationship between the biological characteristics of marine communities and the environmental and anthropogenic parameters to which they are currently subjected.
