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Cristina Nunes is Senior Scientist at the Portuguese Institute Sea and Atmosphere (IPMA). She's since 2008 IPMA's scientific co-coordinator of Daily Egg Production Methods (DEPM) surveys applied to sardine and horse-mackerel in Iberian waters, and coordinator of the research work and stock assessment of Atlantic chub mackerel. She is member of several ICES WGs related to SPF surveys and the provision of reproductive biological parameters.
